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## COACHING POLICY

Cronulla RSL Soccer Club is founded on the principles of providing opportunities for young people to be involved in sport (with all the benefits that confers) and the promotion of positive values including but not confined to good sportsmanship, inclusion and respect for both self and others. It is important that all Coaches, Players and Parents conduct themselves in keeping with these principles at all times (refer to Club Code of Conduct).

All Coaches will be encouraged to attain coaching certification appropriate to both the age and skill level they are coaching.

To facilitate the above aim, Cronulla RSL Soccer Club will offer access to Level 0 (Grass Roots), Level 1 and Level 2 coaching courses in the pre-season period for interested people. Where possible and when numbers allow these will be run at Solander field, otherwise we will utilise courses run by the Sutherland Shire Football Association (SSFA) or Football NSW. The cost of these courses will be fully met by Cronulla RSL Soccer Club. Additional age specific Skills and Drills sessions for Coaches will be conducted at regular intervals throughout the season to endeavour to ensure that training sessions remain varied and interesting for players throughout the season. Coaches may nominate their team to facilitate demonstration of drills during these sessions. Dates/times for these sessions will be advised both on the Club website and via email to existing coaches.

A stock of equipment that may be useful for training sessions and drills will be accessible to Coaches at Solander on all training days.
