



COACH | MANAGER | GROUND CONTROL GAME DAY INFO

Manager & Coaches

- Coach and Manager must be named on the match sheet before the game and one must sign it after the match.
- Manager wears a YELLOW VEST for the entire game.
- Manager is to help control team behaviour and work with the referee, opposition Manager, and Ground Control to address any issues.
- Coaching from the sideline (Under 12 and up) must happen from within the Technical Area only; no pacing the sidelines!
- The Technical Area is only for Coaches and Players Managers can also go into this area if needed to attend to a player

Ground Control

- Ground Control people are required to wear a fluoro ORANGE VEST for the entire game.
- Each team must provide one adult in an orange vest as Ground Control (**this cannot be the coach or manager**)
- They must be named on the match sheet.
- The Ground Control person is responsible for:
 - Ensuring that their own teams' spectators to DO NOT enter field or gather around the goals
 - Speaking to their spectators if needed to ensure they are min. 1m behind the sidelines and conducting themselves appropriately.
 - If needed they can work with the Club Official (*the overarching Ground Control nominated/supplied by the Club of the location you're playing on*).
